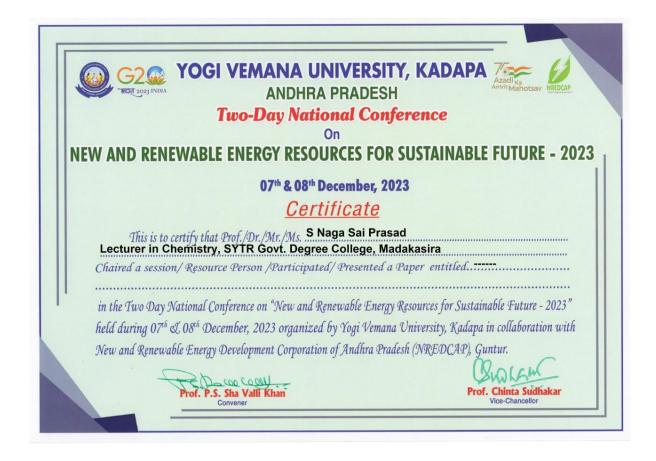

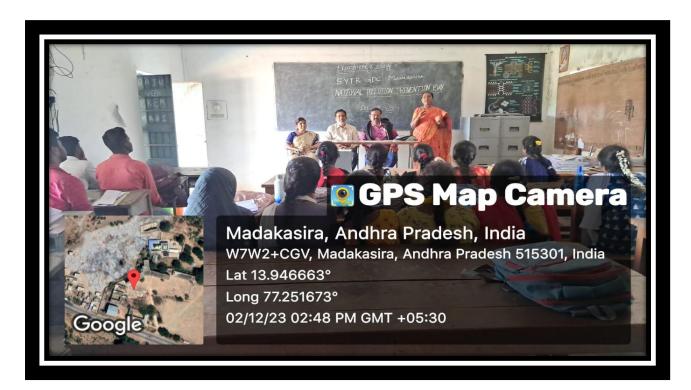
ACTIVITIES FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2023

harmful gases. So to aware the students to prevent the pollution to create pollution free environment.



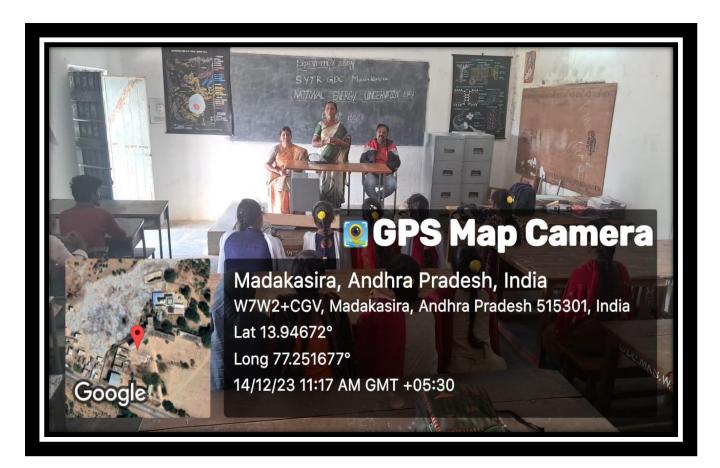


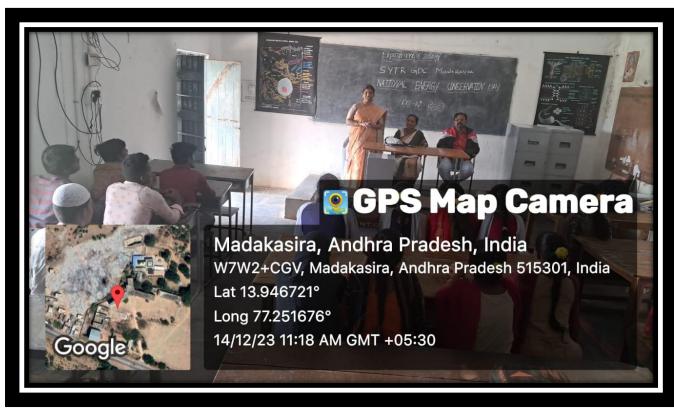
NATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION DAY

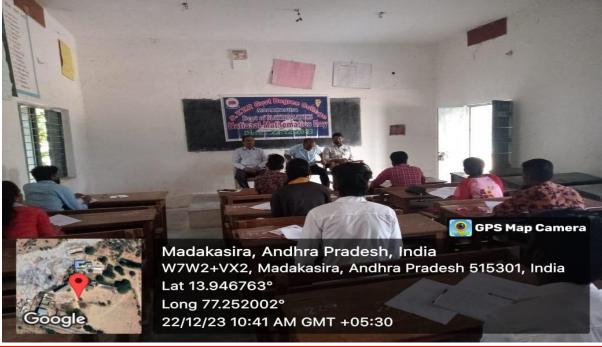


DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS:
